

## JSGCT Travel Grant 2024

### Purpose:

JSGCT will award "JSGCT Travel Grant 2024" to young researchers (under 45 years old) who will make excellent presentations at the JSGCT Annual Meeting in hopes of further development of their research.

### <Awards>

- At the general assembly of the JSGCT Annual Meeting, the board chairman will commend the winners and give them supplementary prizes (subsidies).
- Research grant amount: Up to 200,000 yen Up to 2 people from outside Japan, Up to 30,000 yen Up to 5 people in Japan. The grants are not intended to cover all travel expenses.

### <Recruitment/selection method>

#### 1. Qualification requirements

- Full member of JSGCT (former JSGT) who has been a member for more than 1 year at the time of the application deadline
- A researcher who belongs to a public research institution and is engaged in research activities (whether full-time or part-time)
- Nationality does not matter.
- Those who are 45 years old or younger at the time of application. Including graduate students
- A main speaker at JSGCT2024 (<https://square.umin.ac.jp/jsgct2024/>)

#### Supplementary note:

Applicants will accept the funds, and in principle, they will be used for travel-related expenses.

#### 2. Application

- Please submit a series of documents to apply for the JSGCT travel grant via e-mail (address to: [maf-jsgct@mynavi.jp](mailto:maf-jsgct@mynavi.jp)).
- An application form must contain the following information.
  - Name, Date of Birth, Affiliation of an applicant
  - Contact address
  - A condensed curriculum vitae
  - A title of the presentation
  - Travel expenses to request (note that there is an upper limit)
- The deadline: Refer to the abstract submission deadline for the JSGCT 2024.
